

Oregon College of Art and Craft (OCAC) and Memphis College of Art (MCA)

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

November 1, 2017

Purpose

The purpose of this agreement is to provide students interested in pursuing a Bachelor of Fine Arts at Oregon College of Art and Craft with the opportunity of a direct transfer from Memphis College of Art (MCA) to Oregon College of Art and Craft (OCAC). This agreement facilitates the transfer of credits earned from coursework at MCA towards satisfying OCAC's BFA degree requirements.

Upon successful completion of the first year at Memphis College of Art, a student may transfer these MCA credits to OCAC to allow direct entry into the OCAC second year.

Further, an MCA student at another point in the student's degree coursework at MCA, will have the successfully completed MCA coursework accepted in direct transfer to OCAC.

Terms and Conditions:


MCA students who have successfully completed their first-year courses with a grade of 'C' or better will be accepted for direct transfer to the second year of OCAC's BFA program.

MCA students who have completed degree coursework at another point other than first year completion with a 'C' or better may apply for a direct transfer to OCAC's BFA program. All MCA credits will transfer to OCAC.

1. The transfer process includes:
 - a. Online Application for direct transfer
 - b. Portfolio (12-24 pieces for review purposes only)
 - c. Artist Statement/Interview (for review purposes only)
 - d. Completed FAFSA
 - e. MCA transcripts
2. Upon admission, the student's credits will be transferred in and evaluated. All credits taken at MCA will be applied toward the 120 credits required for graduation at OCAC. MCA will provide official transcripts to OCAC upon request of eligible students. OCAC will waive all transcript fees.
3. This Agreement will come into effect on December 1, 2017. Both MCA (the sending institution) and OCAC (the receiving institution) are responsible for advising the other institution of curriculum changes as they occur. Substantive changes over the life of the agreement, as determined by OCAC, may result in the revision or negation of this agreement.
4. To help aid in the articulation process OCAC will waive application fees to MCA students who apply


