Students who graduate from a non-Tennessee high school that falls within 250 miles of Tennessee Tech University will be eligible for a tuition reduction program.

Students are eligible to apply for School of Art, Craft & Design scholarships; application deadline February 2018. Students should also apply for other University scholarships via TTU ScholarWeb by December 1, 2017. Note: Eligibility for SAC&D scholarships typically requires completion of the ScholarWeb application by Dec. 1, however this deadline will be waived for MCA transfer students. Students who transfer to TTU will be required to complete the ScholarWeb application prior to January 31 if they intend to apply for SAC&D scholarships in February 2018.

Students are eligible to live on the main campus in campus housing or at the School of Art, Craft & Design satellite campus, the Appalachian Center for Craft (25 miles from the main campus in Cookeville, TN).

- Main campus resident Hall room, approximately \$2500/semester

- Main campus meal plan, approximately \$2300/semester

- Craft Center housing: single room \$1175, shared room \$2250

  - Note: there is not a meal plan option at the Craft Center, all housing units have kitchens which allow students to prepare their own meals. However, there is an on-site café where students can purchase breakfast and lunch per meal.

  - Note: freshmen students are not typically allowed to reside at the Craft Center but this restriction is being waived for MCA transfers.

Students have opportunity to utilize the free Craft Center shuttle to commute between main campus and the Craft Center.
