Please accept this letter as validation that the School of Art in the J. William Fulbright College of Arts and Sciences at the University of Arkansas will accept Art transfer credit from the Memphis College of Art based on the guidelines and policies of the University of Arkansas.

Any student transferring to the University of Arkansas's School of Art from the Memphis College of Art will be accepted into our programs (following University of Arkansas policy). The twenty-four credit hours from the Memphis College of Art's Foundations Curriculum will be accepted as full equivalency to the School of Art's eighteen credits of Foundations Curriculum, with the additional 3 credits substituting a Drawing elective, required in the BFA Studio Art credit or to be used as an elective credit in Drawing for the BA in Art History, BA in Studio Art, BFA in Art Education or the BFA in Graphic Design, if the student made a grade of a C or better in these courses.

All other transfer courses will be individually assessed by our Art Faculty and given credit when there is a course equivalency following the guidelines of the University of Arkansas policies.

The School of Art at the University of Arkansas will make every effort to support the students transferring from the Memphis College of Art and provide additional assistance to aid in the smooth transition of these students into the School of Art.
