


Articulation Agreement

PURPOSE


Watkins College of Art (Watkins) and Memphis College of Art (MCA) have entered into a partnership that promotes student transfer and program articulation. The partnership will assist with the transfer of Bachelor of Fine Art (BFA) course credit from MCA to Watkins's BFA programs.

The intent of the agreement is to assist MCA students to complete the BFA under the terms of the agreement prior to transfer to Watkins. The attached program matrixes identify all possible credit transfer from the MCA program majors identified in the *Traditional Four-Year Course Progression* (downloaded from the Web) to Watkins' program majors in accordance with the 2017-18 course catalog. Some courses listed on student transcripts, but not identified on the *Traditional Four-Year Course Progression* or the Program Matrix will be addressed on a case-by-case basis. Watkins will make every effort to transfer all credited awarded in MCA program majors to Watkins' program majors. All other academic regulations of the major degree, college/school and university standards (such as grade point average and retention requirements) must be satisfied.

1. In order to be eligible for admission to Watkins under the terms of the agreement, the student must have a minimum of 2.0 grade point average.
2. Individual course transcript grades must be C- or above. Any course grade below C- will not be accepted as transfer credit.
3. When entering Watkins, students must meet the standards and follow the procedures outlined in the Watkins undergraduate catalog for the current catalog year of entry.
4. In addition to the specific course requirements for a bachelor's degree, all transfer students must satisfy any specific program, major, or degree requirements that might be required for progression and retention in a specific program as well as all of the college's requirements for residency and graduation.
5. The awarding or use of any nontraditional credit (e.g. CLEP, AP credit-by-exam, military services, etc.) must be approved Watkins.
6. This agreement will commence January 2018.
