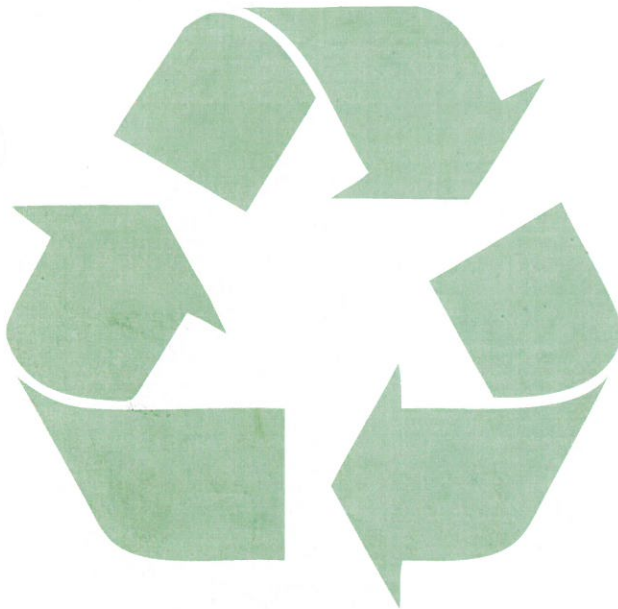




ENVIROMENTAL POLICY

- Use materials and supplies where feasible that minimize harm to the environment, and avoid use of non-renewable resources.
- Incorporate environmental and energy management policies into employee and student orientation and promote awareness of the need to practice the aims of this environmental policy.
- Set targets for reducing energy use throughout the college by creating an environment of energy conservation.
- Remove material from the waste stream that can be recycled and make use of recycled materials where practicable.
- Minimize pollution by ensuring that all MCA vehicles that use fossil fuels are regularly monitored for emissions quality.
- Ensure that all contractors and suppliers to MCA practice legal and sustainable environmental standards.
- Cooperate with local organizations to encourage environmental practice within the Memphis community.
- Ensure compliance with any legal requirements concerning the environment and working towards meeting government initiatives for a sustainable environment.
- Encourage students, faculty and staff to seek environmentally acceptable use of transportation, i.e. rideshare, shuttle, bike.
- Reduce paper waste by encouraging the use of electronic methods of information delivery.
